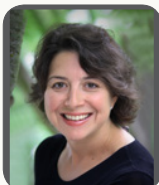

Building on its highly regarded, long-standing, and year-long training program for Certified Yoga Teachers and Yoga Therapists, the Niroga Institute is currently accepting applications for its Level 3 training program for Certified Yoga Therapy Specialists, starting February 2012.

The training will be led by Bidyut K. Bose, PhD, Master Yoga Therapist in the Raja Yoga tradition and Executive Director of Niroga Institute.
